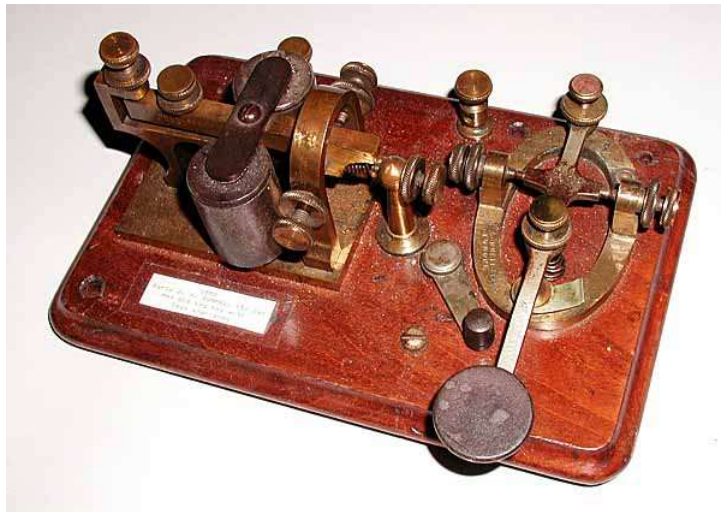


# *Herndon Depot Museum*
